The Jefferson County Department of Health hereby gives notice of the proposed changes to the Jefferson County Board of Health Regulations for Communal Living Facilities.


The proposed Regulations are revised under Alabama Act 06-591, Alabama Legislature 2006 authorizing the Jefferson County Department of Health to adopt and enforce rules and regulations concerning the operation of boarding and rooming homes in Jefferson County.
