PUBLIC NOTICE

The Jefferson County Department of Health gives notice that ABC Coke has applied for a renewal Title V Operating Permit for its facility located at 900 Huntsville Avenue, Tarrant, Alabama 35217. ABC Coke is a by-product coke plant. Coal is heated to drive off the volatile organic compounds (VOCs), producing coke. The VOCs are recovered to produce clean coke oven gas for combustion on-site, and to produce light oil and tar, which are saleable by-products. The draft permit does not authorize new emissions.

Copies of the draft Permit may be inspected at the office of Environmental Health Services (Air & Radiation Protection Division), Jefferson County Department of Health, located at 1400 Sixth Avenue South, Birmingham, Alabama, from 7:45 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday (holidays excluded). Single copies of the draft permit and other documents may be obtained free of charge. Copies of the draft permit, application and statement of basis may be viewed online at <https://webapps.jcdh.org/scores/EHAIR/APCPublicNotices.aspx>.

Within thirty (30) days following the publication date of this notice (by September 21, 2018), any interested person may request a public hearing. A request for a public hearing must indicate the reasons why a hearing is requested. If the Department determines that a petition constitutes cause or that there is significant public interest in the permit, the Health Officer may schedule a hearing.

The Jefferson County Department of Health, Air and Radiation Protection Division, is limited only to the air pollution aspect of the facility. Any comments relative to zoning

or economic and social impact are within the purview of local zoning and planning authorities and should be directed to them.

After consideration of all written comments and a review of the public hearing record, the Department will make a final determination regarding permit issuance.
