PUBLIC NOTICE

The Jefferson County Department of Health gives notice that Southern Gas Company, has applied for a Synthetic Minor Operating Permit for the Trussville LNG Plant, located at 7389 Gas Line Road, Trussville, Alabama 35173. The existing facility has an air permit for a combustion turbine used to liquefy natural gas for storage. The application requests to increase the capacity of the turbine but will remain an area source of all pollutants by restricting the hours of operation of the modified turbine. The revised permit will also include requirements for 2 emergency generators.

Copies of the draft Permit may be inspected at the office of Environmental Health Services (Air & Radiation Protection Division), Jefferson County Department of Health, located at 1400 Sixth Avenue South, Birmingham, Alabama, from 7:45 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday (holidays excluded). Copies of the draft permit and other documents may be obtained for a fee of \$5.00 plus \$0.25 per page. Copies of the draft permit and application may be viewed online at [www.jcdh.org](http://www.jcdh.org) by selecting the following menu items: Programs & Services/ Environmental Health/ Air & Radiation Protection Division/ Air Program Public Notices.

Within fifteen (15) days following the publication date of this notice, any interested person may request a public hearing. A request for a public hearing must indicate the reasons why a hearing is requested. If the Department determines that a petition constitutes cause or that there is significant public interest in the permit, the Health Officer may schedule a hearing.

The Jefferson County Department of Health is limited only to the air pollution aspect of the facility. Any comments relative to zoning or economic and social impact are within the purview of local zoning and planning authorities and should be directed to them.

After consideration of all written comments and a review of the public hearing record, the Department will make a final determination regarding permit issuance.
